

# MCHD - BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER PROGRAM

The **MCHD - Breast and Cervical Cancer Program** is open to Maverick, Val Verde, Dimmitt, Uvalde, Zavala, Kinney County and Kickapoo Traditional Tribe residents who are not eligible for Medicaid or do not have private health insurance; and whose total household income does not exceed 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, meets established residency, household composition and resource requirements.

MCHD-BCCS does not own or operate a hospital but eligible clients may receive services through the local hospital and other contracted providers.

## IDENTIFICATION

Please provide the following:

- Valid Texas Driver's License/ID with current address
- Birth Certificate
- Social Security Card
- Passport (*can be used if Birth Certificate not available*)
- Resident Alien Card (*can be used if Birth Certificate not available*)
- Voter Registration Card (*can be used if current utility bill not available*)

Please provide the following document with physical address dated within the past 30 days:

- Current utility bill (electric, water) with physical address.

- Check stubs from the month prior of application month showing name, date, employer and gross income
- Proof of retirement income
- Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) Notice of Benefits
- Social Security Disability Award Letter
- Self-Employment Income Statement or Income Tax Return including 1099
- Other documents verifying income
